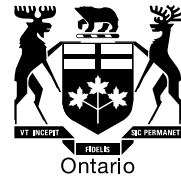

In its Decision and Order dated May 1, 2012 the Board ordered intervenors to file with the Board and forward to Lakefront their respective cost claims within **7 days** from the date of issuance of the final Rate Order and Lakefront to file any objections within **14 days** of the final Rate Order. The Rate Order was issued May 17, 2012 such that intervenors costs claims should have been filed by May 24 and Lakefront's objections, if any, should have been filed by May 31, 2012. Responses to any objections should have been filed by June 7, 2012.

The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) filed its cost claim on May 25 and the School Energy Coalition (SEC) filed its cost claim on June 1, both past the deadline set by the Board. The Board has decided to accept the cost claims, notwithstanding their late filing, and considers it necessary to allow Lakefront additional time to respond to the costs claims. Accordingly, Lakefront shall have until **June 15, 2012** to respond to the cost claims submitted by VECC and SEC. VECC and SEC shall have until **June 22, 2012** to respond to Lakefront's comments.
