2. Under s. 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, an application for an order under s. 78 may be made only with the written approval of the Minister if the application relates to: rates for the distributing of electricity...
3. The Delivery charges are already not reasonable and discriminatory because impose the double charges for electricity for the consumers of 500 kWh per billing period, or even the delivery charges exceed the price for actual consumed electricity.
4. The flat rate of customer Charge (that includes in the Delivery charges) is a discrimination ~~and~~ a violation of s.1(e) of the Electricity Act, 1998, and a violation of s.1 of the Human Rights Code (Ontario) - by an infringement of the human rights to equal treatment with respect to services.
