

Re: IESO Registration

Loblaw Companies Limited has committed to register a number of our large facilities into the IESO-administrated wholesale market in order to participate in IESO-enabled programs. The stores we have targeted in your service territory are listed in Schedule A appended to this letter. When registered with the IESO, individual stores loads will be aggregated and the IESO will issue one energy bill. The stores identified in Schedule A will form part of a larger group of stores located throughout the province to be registered with the IESO.

There is much work to be done in order for the individual store aggregation to commence by April 1, 2012. For this reason, we have engaged the services of Rodan Energy Solutions Inc. (Rodan) to facilitate all aspects of IESO facility registration and transition matters with local distribution companies. Rodan is an IESO registered Metering Service Provider (MSP) with extensive experience in metering and registering metering installations with the IESO. The registration and transition steps are as follows:

- Assessing existing LDC metering installation for conformity with the IESO metering standard. This will include an on-site review of the metering configuration and metering assets. Target Date: January 16th, 2012
- Conveying IESO compliant metering assets to Loblaw. Target Date: February 17th, 2012
- Upgrading metering and commissioning the metering installation into the IESO wholesale market. Target Date: March 30th, 2012
- 4. Providing communications access so that the LDC can continue to remotely interrogate the meter and issue bills. **Target Date: Upon Commissioning**

Upon conveyance of the metering assets to Loblaw and commissioning with the IESO you will no longer be responsible for the maintenance of the metering installation including communication troubleshooting and resolution. The IESO will be settling the energy and Global Adjustment charges directly with Loblaw, however, we will still continue to be your customer for transmission tariff settlement. It is for this reason that you will continue to have access to the metered data in a format that is compatible with your settlement system.
