IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Haldimand County Hydro Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for an Order or Orders approving or fixing just and reasonable rates for the disposition of Account 1562 Deferred Payments in Lieu of Taxes ("PILs") as of May 1, 2012.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 June 22, 2012

Haldimand County Hydro Inc. ("HCHI") applied to the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") for approval to dispose of the balance in Account 1562, Deferred Payments in Lieu of Taxes ("Account 1562") over a one-year period, effective May 1, 2012. The Application was filed on January 27, 2012 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2012-0027. The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing and Procedural Order No. 1 (the "Notice") dated May 7, 2012.

In the Notice, the Board established certain filing dates for responses to interrogatories and submissions from Board-approved intervenors and Board staff and reply submission from HCHI.

On June 21, 2012, HCHI filed a letter requesting an extension of five days to the deadlines set out in the Notice in order to complete the interrogatory responses.

The Board grants the extension requested by HCHI and hereby cancels the filing dates as established in the Notice. The Board has established new dates for the filing of interrogatory responses, submissions and reply submissions, as set out below.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. HCHI shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to all intervenors no later than **June 26**, **2012**.
- 2. Written submissions by intervenors or Board staff must be filed with the Board, and copied to all other parties, by **July 10, 2012**.
- 3. If HCHI wishes to respond to the submissions, its written response must be filed with the Board and delivered to all other parties, by **July 24, 2012**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2012-0027, be made through the Board's web portal at https://www.errr.ontarioenergyboard.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies. All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
