**Re: East-West Tie Transmitter Designation Process

We are counsel to Iccon Transmission, Inc. ("Iccon"), an applicant in this proceeding.

Pursuant to the Board's Phase I partial Decision and Order — Production of Documents, we enclose Declarations and Undertakings signed by Iccon's legal counsel, Glenn Zacher and Patrick Duffy.


We plan to deliver additional signed Declarations and Undertakings from Iccon's consultants or employees who require access to unredacted versions of the HONI and GLP documents. Any request by non-consultants for access will include reasons for the request.

Please note, however, that Iccon may need to submit requests for access by additional personnel after July 6, 2012. The reason for this is that Iccon may not be in a position to identify which additional personnel require access to the confidential documents until we review the documents and the nature and extent of any redactions; and, the Board issues the balance of its Phase I decision. We may not be able to make this determination prior to July 6, 2012. As well, it is possible that in the course of preparing its transmission development plan, Iccon will identify additional consultants or employees who require access to the unredacted
