Re: Request for Confidential Treatment of Information Associated with Great Lakes Power Transmission LP's Application for 2013 and 2014 Transmission Rates (EB-2012-0300)

We are counsel to Great Lakes Power Transmission LP ("GLPT") in respect of GLPT's Application for 2013 and 2014 Transmission Rates (EB-2012-0300) (the "Application"). The Application was filed on June 29, 2012.

In parallel with the filing of the Application and written evidence, on behalf of GLPT we are hereby filing a request for the confidential treatment of certain information which is intended to form part of the written evidence in support of the Application (the "Confidentiality Request"). This Confidentiality Request is being filed in accordance with the Board's *Practice Direction on Confidential Filings*.

The purpose of this Confidentiality Request is to protect the confidentiality of certain information that, if disclosed, would either (i) reveal information that for public security reasons must be kept confidential or (ii) prejudice GLPT's load customers.

The nature of the risks are described further within the confidential version of the document contained in **Attachment "A"**. GLPT seeks confidential treatment of the document contained in Attachment "A" in its entirety.

A non-confidential version of the document that is the subject of the Confidentiality Request is provided in **Attachment "B"**.

Non-Confidential Summary

The confidential information consists of written, pre-filed evidence in support of GLPT's application for 2013 and 2014 transmission rates. In particular, this information describes (i) certain standards of the North American Electric Reliability Corporation that are relevant to GLPT's transmission system and which require confidentiality; and (ii) historical and forecasted charge determinant data that, if disclosed, would prejudice GLPT's load customers. In both cases, the particular prejudice to the third parties involved outweighs the benefit to the public of disclosure.
