## **ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD**

**IN THE MATTER OF** the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.55; and in particular Section 8 thereof;

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by Union Gas Limited for an Order supersede, and expand the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the amalgamated Corporation of the Town of Milton.

## APPLICATION OF UNION GAS LIMITED

- 1. Union Gas Limited ("Union"), a regulated public utility, is a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, with its head office at the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, in the Province of Ontario.
- 2. The Corporation of the Town of Milton (the "Municipality") is a municipal corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario. Attached hereto and marked as Schedule "A" is a map showing the location of the Municipality.
- 3. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (F.B.C. 324) was issued by the Ontario Fuel Board on June 24, 1959 granting United Gas Limited the right to construct works to supply natural gas to 14 municipalities. The former Town of Milton, the former Township of Trafalgar and a portion of the former Township of Esquesing (the other portion is now within the Town of Halton Hills) were three of these municipalities that now form the Town of Milton.
- 4. In 1974 a portion of the former Township of Nassagaweya became part of the Town of Milton (the remainder was annexed to what is now the Township of Guelph Eramosa). Union has not been able to find evidence that it has a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the portion of the former Township of Nassagaweya that is now within the Town of Milton.
- 5. Union now applies to the Ontario Energy Board for an Order superseding those parts of the existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (F.B.C. 324) relating to the former Town of Milton, the former Township of Trafalgar and a portion of the former Township of Esquesing that now form the Town of Milton and replacing them with a single, expanded Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity that also includes a portion of the former Township of Nassagaweya (for the amalgamated Corporation of the Town of Milton).

- 6. Union requests that this Application be dealt with by way of a written hearing in accordance with Section 34.01 of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
