Further to our letter dated June 27, 2012, we enclose two additional signed Declarations and Undertakings of Jose Soto Martinez and Pablo de la Sierra Perez. As stated in our June 27, 2012 letter, we anticipate that Iccon may file Declarations and Undertakings from further employees or consultants whom Iccon identifies in the course of reviewing the HONI and GLPT documents and preparing its transmission development plan.

The Declaration and Undertaking from Mr. de la Sierra Perez has been modified to reflect the fact that he is neither counsel nor a consultant for Iccon; he is a director and officer of Iccon.


Mr. de la Sierra Perez requires access to the confidential redacted information contained in the documents produced by HONI and GLPT because Mr. de la Sierra Perez is the Iccon representative who is principally responsible for overseeing and managing Iccon's participation in this proceeding, including overseeing and managing the preparation of a transmission development plan. Specifically, Mr. de la Sierra Perez requires access to the confidential information so that he may effectively coordinate and communicate with counsel and other Iccon team members and consultants in preparing Iccon's transmission development plan. Initially, Mr. de la Sierra Perez also requires access to the confidential information so that he may, in consultation with Iccon's counsel and authorized consultants, determine what

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other Icon team members or consultants may require access to the confidential information in order to assist in preparing Icon's transmission development plan. Mr. de la Sierra Perez agrees, as evidenced by his signed Declaration and Undertaking, to maintain the redacted information in strict confidence in accordance with the terms of the Declaration and Undertaking.




