IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2012.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 3 July 18, 2012

Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation ("Chapleau" or the "Applicant") applied to the Ontario Energy Board for permission to increase its delivery charges beginning May 1, 2012. The complete application was filed on March 16, 2012 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B).

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing dated April 13, 2012. On May 4, 2012, the Board issued Procedural Oder No. 1 which set dates for interrogatories and interrogatory responses. On June 1, 2012 the Board issued Procedural Order No. 2 extending the date for Interrogatory responses to June 20, 2012.

The Board has reviewed the responses and has determined that a second round of interrogatories specifically to clarify some of the responses to the current interrogatories is required.

The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff and VECC shall file interrogatories seeking clarification of the current interrogatory responses on or before **July 25, 2012**.
- 2. Responses to the Interrogatories are to be filed no later than **August 10, 2012**.
- 3. Board staff shall file its submission on or before **August 24, 2012.** VECC shall file its submission no later than **August 28, 2012.**
- Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation shall file its Reply Argument no later than September 7, 2012

All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2011-0322, be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.ontarioenergyboard.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the BoardSec@ontarioenergyboard.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file seven paper copies. If you have submitted through the Board's web portal an e-mail is not required."

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
