**Re: Plateau and Pointe-Aux-Roches Wind -- Application for Interim and Final Electricity Generation Licences**

We are counsel to Plateau Wind Inc. ("Plateau Inc.") and Pointe-Aux-Roches Wind Inc. ("PAR Inc."), which hold electricity generation licenses EG-2011-0346 and EG-2010-0301, respectively (together, the "Existing Licenses"). Plateau Inc.'s Existing License covers 27 MW of wind generating facilities in Municipality of Grey Highlands and the Township of Melancthon (the "Plateau Facilities"). PAR Inc.'s Existing License covers approximately 49 MW of wind generating facilities in the Town of Lakeshore (the "PAR Facilities").

On or about August 24, 2012, as part of an internal reorganization of Plateau Inc., PAR Inc. and their affiliates, the Plateau Facilities will be transferred from Plateau Inc. to Plateau Wind L.P. ("Plateau LP") and the PAR Facilities will be transferred from PAR Inc. to Pointe-Aux-Roches Wind L.P. ("PAR LP"). Thus, to remain in compliance with section 57(c) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* ("OEB Act"), Plateau LP and PAR LP will require electricity generation licenses prior to August 24, 2012. Once final licenses are issued to Plateau LP and PAR LP, the Board can remove the Plateau and PAR Facilities from the schedules to the Existing Licenses.

Therefore, on behalf of Plateau Inc., PAR Inc., Plateau LP and PAR LP:

1. We have enclosed applications for new electricity generation licenses for each of Plateau LP and PAR LP, along with the applicable Notices to Proceed and a cheque for \$2,000 payable to the Board to cover the application fees. We request that the Plateau Facilities be listed on a new license issued to Plateau LP, and that the PAR Facilities be listed on a new license issued to PAR LP. We also request, pursuant to section 34.01 of the Board's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, that these license applications proceed by way of a written hearing. Finally, to accommodate the timing of the reorganization, we request

that the Board expedite its hearing of the license applications in accordance with sections 2.01 and 7.01 of the *Rules*.

2. In the event that final licenses cannot be issued to Plateau LP and PAR LP prior to August 24, 2012, we request that the Board, pursuant to its authority under section 21(7) of the OEB Act, issue interim generation licenses to each of Plateau LP and PAR LP prior to August 24, 2012. These licenses would cover the Plateau and PAR Facilities, respectively. We request that these interim licenses remain in full force and effect until the Board issues its final Decisions and Orders with respect to the enclosed applications. We note that there is the precedent for the Board issuing such interim licenses to accommodate the timing of an internal reorganization; in particular, we refer you to EB-2011-0333 and EB-2011-0336.
3. Once final electricity generation licenses are issued to each of Plateau LP and PAR LP, we request that the Existing Licenses be amended to remove the Plateau and PAR Facilities from Schedule 1 thereto.

We request that the Board dispose of the requests in 2 and 3 above without a hearing, and this letter is our clients' consent to same. We believe that the requests in 2 and 3 above meet the test set out in section 21(4)(b) of the OEB Act, and that no other person will be adversely affected in a material way either by issuing the requested interim licenses to Plateau LP and PAR LP, or by having the Plateau and PAR Facilities removed from the Existing Licenses. This is the case because any material concerns can be addressed in the course of the applications by Plateau LP and PAR LP for final licenses.

Enclosed are copies of the Existing Licenses as well as the partnership declarations for each of Plateau LP and PAR LP. Please let me know if any further information is required in respect of this application.

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## **1 Definitions**

In this Licence:

“**Act**” means the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B;

“**Electricity Act**” means the *Electricity Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule A;

“**generation facility**” means a facility for generating electricity or providing ancillary services, other than ancillary services provided by a transmitter or distributor through the operation of a transmission or distribution system and includes any structures, equipment or other things used for that purpose;

“**Licensee**” means Plateau Wind Inc.;

“**regulation**” means a regulation made under the Act or the Electricity Act;

## **2 Interpretation**

- 2.1 In this Licence words and phrases shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Act or the Electricity Act. Words or phrases importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa. Headings are for convenience only and shall not affect the interpretation of this Licence. Any reference to a document or a provision of a document includes an amendment or supplement to, or a replacement of, that document or that provision of that document. In the computation of time under this Licence where there is a reference to a number of days between two events, they shall be counted by excluding the day on which the first event happens and including the day on which the second event happens. Where the time for doing an act expires on a holiday, the act may be done on the next day that is not a holiday.

## **3 Authorization**

- 3.1 The Licensee is authorized, under Part V of the Act and subject to the terms and conditions set out in this licence, to generate electricity or provide an ancillary service for sale under a contract with the Ontario Power Authority and the contract is entered into as part of a standard offer program offered by the Ontario Power Authority. This Licence authorizes the Licensee only in respect of those facilities set out in Schedule 1.

## **4 Obligation to Comply with Legislation, Regulations and Market Rules**

- 4.1 The Licensee shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Act and the Electricity Act, and regulations under these acts, except where the Licensee has been exempted from such compliance by regulation.
- 4.2 The Licensee shall comply with all applicable Market Rules.

## **5 Obligation to Maintain System Integrity**

- 5.1 Where the IESO has identified, pursuant to the conditions of its licence and the Market Rules, that it is necessary for purposes of maintaining the reliability and security of the IESO-controlled

grid, for the Licensee to provide energy or ancillary services, the IESO may require the Licensee to enter into an agreement for the supply of energy or such services.

- 5.2 Where an agreement is entered into in accordance with paragraph 5.1, it shall comply with the applicable provisions of the Market Rules or such other conditions as the Board may consider reasonable. The agreement shall be subject to approval by the Board prior to its implementation. Unresolved disputes relating to the terms of the Agreement, the interpretation of the Agreement, or amendment of the Agreement, may be determined by the Board.

## **6 Restrictions on Certain Business Activities**

- 6.1 Neither the Licensee, nor an affiliate of the Licensee shall acquire an interest in a transmission or distribution system in Ontario, construct a transmission or distribution system in Ontario or purchase shares of a corporation that owns a transmission or distribution system in Ontario except in accordance with section 81 of the Act.

## **7 Provision of Information to the Board**

- 7.1 The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board, such information as the Board may require from time to time.
- 7.2 Without limiting the generality of paragraph 7.1 the Licensee shall notify the Board of any material change in circumstances that adversely affects or is likely to adversely affect the business, operations or assets of the Licensee, as soon as practicable, but in any event no more than twenty (20) days past the date upon which such change occurs.

## **8 Term of Licence**

- 8.1 This Licence shall take effect on December 6, 2011 and expire on December 5, 2031. The term of this Licence may be extended by the Board.

## **9 Fees and Assessments**

- 9.1 The Licensee shall pay all fees charged and amounts assessed by the Board.

## **10 Communication**

- 10.1 The Licensee shall designate a person that will act as a primary contact with the Board on matters related to this Licence. The Licensee shall notify the Board promptly should the contact details change.
- 10.2 All official communication relating to this Licence shall be in writing.
- 10.3 All written communication is to be regarded as having been given by the sender and received by the addressee:
- a) when delivered in person to the addressee by hand, by registered mail or by courier;
  - b) ten (10) business days after the date of posting if the communication is sent by regular mail; or

- c) when received by facsimile transmission by the addressee, according to the sender's transmission report.

**11 Copies of the Licence**

**11.1 The Licensee shall:**

- a) make a copy of this Licence available for inspection by members of the public at its head office and regional offices during normal business hours; and
- b) provide a copy of this Licence to any person who requests it. The Licensee may impose a fair and reasonable charge for the cost of providing copies.

**SCHEDULE 1 LIST OF LICENSED GENERATION FACILITIES**

The Licence authorizes the Licensee only in respect to the following:

1. Plateau Wind Farm I & II with a nameplate capacity of 18 MW owned and operated by the licensee and located at in the Municipality of Grey-Highlands and the Township of Melancthon, in the area that is generally bounded by Concession Road 3 to the North, 30 Sideroad to the East, Melancthon Township Line and the Melancthon-Artemesia Townline to the South and Highway 10 to the West.
2. Plateau Wind Farm III with a nameplate capacity of 9 MW within the area bounded by 240 Sideroad to the North, 6<sup>th</sup> Line North-East to the East, County Road 21 to the South and 2<sup>nd</sup> Line Southwest to the West, Township of Melancthon.







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## **1 Definitions**

In this Licence:

“**Act**” means the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B;

“**Electricity Act**” means the *Electricity Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule A;

“**generation facility**” means a facility for generating electricity or providing ancillary services, other than ancillary services provided by a transmitter or distributor through the operation of a transmission or distribution system and includes any structures, equipment or other things used for that purpose;

“**Licensee**” means Pointe-Aux-Roches Wind Inc.;

“**regulation**” means a regulation made under the Act or the Electricity Act;

## **2 Interpretation**

- 2.1 In this Licence words and phrases shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Act or the Electricity Act. Words or phrases importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa. Headings are for convenience only and shall not affect the interpretation of this Licence. Any reference to a document or a provision of a document includes an amendment or supplement to, or a replacement of, that document or that provision of that document. In the computation of time under this Licence where there is a reference to a number of days between two events, they shall be counted by excluding the day on which the first event happens and including the day on which the second event happens. Where the time for doing an act expires on a holiday, the act may be done on the next day that is not a holiday.

## **3 Authorization**

- 3.1 The Licensee is authorized, under Part V of the Act and subject to the terms and conditions set out in this licence, to generate electricity or provide an ancillary service for sale under a contract with the Ontario Power Authority and the contract is entered into as part of a standard offer program offered by the Ontario Power Authority. This Licence authorizes the Licensee only in respect of those facilities set out in Schedule 1.

## **4 Obligation to Comply with Legislation, Regulations and Market Rules**

- 4.1 The Licensee shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Act and the Electricity Act, and regulations under these acts, except where the Licensee has been exempted from such compliance by regulation.
- 4.2 The Licensee shall comply with all applicable Market Rules.

## **5 Obligation to Maintain System Integrity**

- 5.1 Where the IESO has identified, pursuant to the conditions of its licence and the Market Rules, that it is necessary for purposes of maintaining the reliability and security of the IESO-controlled

grid, for the Licensee to provide energy or ancillary services, the IESO may require the Licensee to enter into an agreement for the supply of energy or such services.

- 5.2 Where an agreement is entered into in accordance with paragraph 5.1, it shall comply with the applicable provisions of the Market Rules or such other conditions as the Board may consider reasonable. The agreement shall be subject to approval by the Board prior to its implementation. Unresolved disputes relating to the terms of the Agreement, the interpretation of the Agreement, or amendment of the Agreement, may be determined by the Board.

## **6 Restrictions on Certain Business Activities**

- 6.1 Neither the Licensee, nor an affiliate of the Licensee shall acquire an interest in a transmission or distribution system in Ontario, construct a transmission or distribution system in Ontario or purchase shares of a corporation that owns a transmission or distribution system in Ontario except in accordance with section 81 of the Act.

## **7 Provision of Information to the Board**

- 7.1 The Licensee shall maintain records of and provide, in the manner and form determined by the Board, such information as the Board may require from time to time.
- 7.2 Without limiting the generality of paragraph 7.1 the Licensee shall notify the Board of any material change in circumstances that adversely affects or is likely to adversely affect the business, operations or assets of the Licensee, as soon as practicable, but in any event no more than twenty (20) days past the date upon which such change occurs.

## **8 Term of Licence**

- 8.1 This Licence shall take effect on December 6, 2010 and expire on December 5, 2030. The term of this Licence may be extended by the Board.

## **9 Fees and Assessments**

- 9.1 The Licensee shall pay all fees charged and amounts assessed by the Board.
- 9.2 The Licensee shall designate a person that will act as a primary contact with the Board on matters related to this Licence. The Licensee shall notify the Board promptly should the contact details change.
- 9.3 All official communication relating to this Licence shall be in writing.
- 9.4 All written communication is to be regarded as having been given by the sender and received by the addressee:

  - b) ten (10) business days after the date of posting if the communication is sent by regular mail; or
  - c) when received by facsimile transmission by the addressee, according to the sender's transmission report.
