Re: PUC Distribution Inc.'s Smart Meter Final Disposition Application Responses to Board Staff Comments on Draft Rate Order EB-2012-0084

On July 26, 2012 PUC filed a Draft Rate Order and Board Staff issued comments on PUC's Draft Rate Order on July 27, 2012. Board Staff noted that when calculating the smart meter true-up for each of the customer classes, PUC multiplied the overall true-up by the percentage of historical costs allocated to each class. As a result, the SMFA revenues were allocated to each class in proportion to overall historical smart meter deployment costs instead of being allocated on the basis of SMFA revenues actually collected from each rate class. Board Staff recalculated the class-specific SMDRs, using the approach approved by the Board in the Decision and Order, by taking the difference between the revenue requirement allocated to each class and the SMFA revenues collected from each class. PUC agrees with Board Staff comments including the calculations provided by Board Staff.
