Re: Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge")
Renewable Natural Gas Program Application
EB 2011-0242 Interim Decision and Order dated July 12, 2012

The Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") in its EB-2011-0242 decision directed that Enbridge "may file supplemental evidence to address the issues raised in this decision. Any additional evidence must be filed with the Board and sent to all parties, by October 31, 2012."

Enbridge is currently not in a position to address all of the issues raised in the decision in a manner that is responsive to the decision. Most significantly, it is challenging to conduct a rigorous cost-benefit analysis at this time. As indicated on page 18 of the decision, "The Board understands that there are difficulties in developing a rigorous analysis in this area. For example, there is no market price for carbon in Ontario and although customers will get the value of the environmental attributes, the value of those attributes is highly uncertain."

Enbridge is withdrawing its application without prejudice to future applications that it may bring forward regarding Renewable Natural Gas.
