Festival Hydro Inc. ("Festival Hydro") has applied to the Onlario Energy Board for permission to change its delivery charges beginning May 1, 2013. The application was filed on August 27, 2012 under section 78 of the Onlario Energy Board Act, 1998; S.O. 1998; c.15 (Schedule B), under the Board's guidelines for 3rd Generation Incentive Regulation, Mechanism, which provides for a mechanistic and formulaic adjustment to distribution rates between cost of service applications.

Delivery charges are one of four regular items on Residential and General Service customers: electricity bills delivery charges are one or tool regular learns on residential and control regular to the application is approved as applied for, the monthly bill for a Residential customer who consumes 800 kWh per month would increase by about \$2.20. The monthly bill for a General Service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of less than 50 kW would increase by about \$2.20. The progress Charges to the Delivery, charges are separate from other potential changes to the electricity bills, which are not affected by this application.
