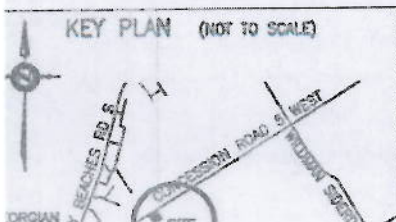

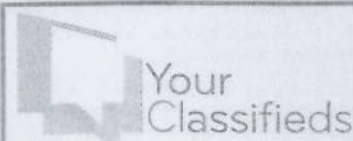

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE

### Midland Power Utility Corporation

Midland Power Utility Corporation ("Midland") has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for permission to change its delivery charges beginning May 1, 2013. The application was filed on August 31, 2012 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B).

Delivery charges are one of four regular items on Residential and General Service customers' electric bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed. If the application is approved as submitted, the monthly bill for a Residential customer who consumes 800 kWh per month will increase by about \$11.10. The monthly bill for a General Service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of less than 50 kW would increase by about \$18.35. Other rate classes will also be affected. These proposed changes to the delivery charges are separate from other potential changes to the electricity bills, which are not affected by this application.

The Board has assigned the application File No. EB-2012-0147. This application will proceed by way of either a written or oral hearing, to be subsequently determined. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of Midland's customers.

Your written request must be received by the Board no later than 10 days from the publication or service date of this notice. #### Personal Information in Letters of Comment and Observer Requests

All letters of comment or letters requesting observer status will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's office and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letters on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e. not business) contact information from the letters (i.e. the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter will become part of the public record.
