Good evening everyone. I would like to address a number of items in the email below. I hope this is helpful for tomorrow's session.

## 1) The SEC Space Requirements Spreadsheet

Enersource has reviewed the material sent earlier today by SEC. We can confirm that the square footage numbers as of the Move-in are correct. Between the Admin and Operations Centre forecasts, there is (approx.) 108K square feet. This is shown in the Appendix 5 at pages 101 and 102 (of 268) of the Board Staff IR 12.

In the time available to review this sheet, we have been unable to match the staff count number of 299, as noted by SEC below.

Please note that during our review of the Space Forecast material in Appendix 5, it was found that there was a cell formula error that affected the staff count figures - but only on the Operations Building Forecast (i.e. only on page 102 of 268). The correct numbers are shown below.

This does not affect the total space or staff count requirements for the Admin Building forecast.

The cell formula error affects only page 102, specifically the columns titled "2011 Occupancy", "Move-in Occupancy" and "Forecast Occupancy" on page 102. The cell formula did not include the top two lines when summing these three columns. The original and revised totals are shown below.

Further, we suggest there is no need to adjust your sheet.
