Dear Ms. Bolton:

Thank you for your letter dated August 28, 2012. Your comments on the Notice of Application and Hearing for an Electricity Distribution Rate Change will be considered in the proceedings of Ontario Energy Board file number EB-2012-0123.

Guelph Hydro has sent your letter to the Ontario Energy Board on September 4th. The Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") will place your letter on their website www.ontarioenergyboard.ca. Before placing the letter on the public record, the OEB will remove any personal contact information. However, your name and the content of the letter will become part of the public record.

Guelph Hydro would like to take this opportunity to briefly explain the regulatory process that exists in Ontario for changing electricity distribution rates.

The OEB establishes the rates of electricity distributors using a combination of annual incentive regulation mechanism ("IRM") adjustments and periodic cost of service reviews. For the 2013 rates, Guelph Hydro applied for an IRM adjustment. The adjustment is calculated based on the inflation rate which is running at around two percent. Guelph Hydro's requested inflationary increase is the equivalent of less than one per cent while still investing in growth and upgrades that keep the lights on to all our customers. The reason why Guelph Hydro is not keeping up with inflation is the OEB requires that we build in productivity improvements into our organization.



Guelph Hydro's team works very hard to promote energy conservation and teach customers how they can save money on their electricity bills.

Today, with smart meters and time-of-use rates, it is even easier for customers to see exactly what hours in the day they use electricity and how much it costs them. Detailed charts are available to customers online. For those customers who do not use the Internet, Customer Service representatives are also available during normal business hours to assist customers in analyzing their electricity usage and identifying ways in which to save money. While we understand that rate increases of any amount can be hard on customers, particularly those on fixed incomes, we hope this letter serves to reassure you that Guelph Hydro recognizes this fact and works very hard to keep costs under control and help customers best manage their electricity bills.
