Electricity Generator License Application
3.9 MW Stan Adamson Hydroelectric Generation Facility**

Please find enclosed two copies of an application for an electricity generation license that would enable the Applicant, Trent Energy Inc., to generate electricity from the 3.9 MW Stan Adamson hydroelectric generating facility under the Ontario Power Authority's Hydroelectric Contract Initiative (HCI).

The Applicant is a wholly owned subsidiary of Peterborough Utilities Inc. (PUI). The Applicant is in the process of acquiring the facility from Trent University. Concurrently, the Applicant is working with the Ontario Power Authority (OPA) to transfer HCI Contract #HCI-0033 to the Applicant under an Assumption and Acknowledgement Agreement (draft copy attached hereto for reference).

Furthermore, as an affiliate of a distributor, Peterborough Distribution Inc., the Applicant is concurrently providing notice of its intent to acquire an interest in generation under section 80 of the Ontario Energy Board Act.

A 40 metre 44kV line from the demarcation point between the generator's system and the distribution system is being installed. The rebuilding of the 44kV lines within Peterborough along the Nassau Mills Road (300 metres) and Water Street (100 metres) is currently under work, along with a 250 metre extension of the 44kV feeder on Armour Road. A relocation of the 44kV transfer switch along Water Street is also being constructed. An Upgrade to the SCADA communications interface from the generation station to PDI and Hydro One is ongoing.


