
This letter responds to counsel for Natural Resource Gas Limited's ("**NRG**") request for an extension for the filing of submissions from today to November 30, 2012. Integrated Grain Processors Co-operative Inc. ("**IGPC**") opposes any extension being granted.

The submissions that are to be filed today deal with the preliminary issue of the Board's jurisdiction. NRG's counsel, Mr. Thacker, has known for several weeks that submissions on jurisdiction were due today. The same arguments about jurisdiction apply whether they relate to the reconciliation of the costs of the pipeline or the adjustment to the security posted.

Importantly, it is clear from Mr. Thacker's letter that NRG accepts that the Board has jurisdiction to deal with the letter of credit issue. Indeed, NRG is contemplating a motion to the Board to request additional security. Accordingly, it appears that the preliminary motion is no longer required and the Board can proceed to issue a Procedural Order timetable to deal with the aid to construct and Letter of Credit issues.
