NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE Welland Hydro-Electric System Corp.



EB-2012-0173

Welland Hydro-Electric System Corp ("Welland Hydro") has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for permission to change its delivery charges beginning May 1, 2013. A complete application was filed on October 9, 2012 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B).

Delivery charges are one of four regular items on Residential and General Service customers' electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed. If the application is approved as applied for, the monthly bill for a Residential customer who consumes 800 kWh per month will increase by about \$0.83. The monthly bill for a General Service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of less than 50 kW would increase by about \$2.64. The proposed changes to the Delivery charges are separate from other potential changes to the electricity bills, which are not affected by this application.
