AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Hydro One Networks Inc. for an Order granting leave to construct to upgrade existing transmission line facilities.

## PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 6 October 25, 2012

Hydro One Networks Inc. ("Hydro One") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board dated March 28, 2012 under section 92 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B. Hydro One applied for an order of the Board granting leave to construct to upgrade 70 km of transmission line facilities between Lambton TS and Longwood TS (the "Project") in the west of London area.

On August 20, 2012 a letter was received from the Haudenosaunee Development Institute ("HDI") indicating that it had just become aware of the application and that it should have been served, and wished to participate. The Board issued Procedural Order No. 4 on September 18, 2012 in which it determined that HDI should have been provided notice. The Board granted intervenor status to HDI, and made provision for HDI to file interrogatories and submissions, and for Hydro One to submit interrogatory responses, and reply submissions. This schedule was subsequently extended.

On October 23 Hydro One advised the Board that it had not sent the material to HDI's counsel until that day. On October 23, 2012 HDI sent an email advising that the interrogatory responses had been sent to the wrong address, and that "submissions would be sent in due course." Given that Hydro One provided the interrogatory answers to HDI's counsel one week after the deadline of October 16, the Board will extend the time for HDI to file its submission November 1 2012. The deadline for Hydro One to file reply submissions will be extended to November 8, 2012.

The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

## THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Haudenosaunee Development Institute may file with the Board and copy to Hydro One and all other intervenors its written submission on all matters within the limits of the Board's jurisdiction in applications of this type and the scope of the proceeding by **November 1, 2012**.
- 2. Hydro One shall file its reply submission with the Board and copy to all intervenors by **November 8, 2012**.

All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2012-0082, be made through the Board's web portal at <a href="https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/">https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</a>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties shall use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <a href="https://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca">www.ontarioenergyboard.ca</a>.

If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
