## Board File No. EB-2007-0905 Payment Amounts for Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s Prescribed Facilities Intervenor Evidence Schedule

Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) wishes to notify the Board that it is in general support of the letter filed today by Mr. Mark Rodger, counsel for the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario (AMPCO), requesting an extension of the filing date for its evidence.

A number of responses to Energy Probe's interrogatories have been delayed due to the volume of interrogatories directed to the Applicant. In addition, the response to Energy Probe Interrogatory # 17, while received on April 16<sup>th</sup>, contains corrections to financial information originally filed in Ontario Power Generation's evidence. This will require our consulting economist to rerun his calculations and possibly to revisit the presentation of the results prior to the filing of Energy Probe's evidence.

We are therefore requesting an extension of the filing date for the Energy Probe evidence. The suggestion by AMPCO in its letter that the schedule revisions provided to the intervenors that have retained Lawrence Booth be extended to it appears to Energy Probe to be most reasonable in the circumstances. Similar treatment would satisfy the requirements of Energy Probe in respect of the revision of its evidence.
