PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 13
November 6, 2012

The Canadian Distributed Antenna Systems Coalition (“CANDAS”) filed an application on April 25, 2011, subsequently amended by letters dated May 3 and June 7, 2011. The Board issued its Decision on Preliminary Issue and Order on September 13, 2012, which concluded the proceeding. On November 1, 2012, the Board issued its Decision on Cost Eligibility and Cost Responsibility and Order wherein the Board ordered eligible intervenors - Consumer Council of Canada (“CCC”), Energy Probe Research Foundation (“Energy Probe”), and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (“VECC”) to submit their cost claims no later than November 8, 2012.

On November 2, 2012, CCC filed a letter requesting an extension to November 15, 2012 for the filing of its cost claim. The Board will accommodate this request by amending the timelines associated with the cost claims process for all parties.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. CCC, Energy Probe, and VECC shall submit their cost claims no later than November 15, 2012. These cost claims will be made available for viewing on the Board's website.

2. CANDAS and any licensed electricity distributor shall file with the Board and forward to CCC, Energy Probe, and VECC any objections to the claimed costs on or before November 22, 2012.
3. CCC, Energy Probe, and VECC shall file with the Board and forward to CANDAS any responses to any objections for cost claims on or before November 29, 2012. Any responses will be posted on the Board's website.

All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2011-0120, be made through the Board's web portal at, <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/> and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca. If the web portal is not available parties may email their document to BoardSec@ontarioenergyboard.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 2 paper copies.
