In reviewing the Draft Interim Rate Order circulated by EGD on November 5, 2012, we noticed, at Exhibit H2, Tab 2, Schedule 1, lines 5 and 9, in Column 8, that the revenues under proposed rates for Rates 110 and 145 are increasing, while the rates for the other rate classes are decreasing. Also, at line 14, we note that the revenue from storage is increasing by almost 10%.

We asked the company to explain the causes for the revenues in these rates classes to increase while the revenues from all other rate classes are decreasing as a result of the settlement which produces a revenue sufficiency of about \$4M.

We received a prompt response from EGD that alleviates our concerns and we have no objections to the Order EGD proposes.
