Re: Union Gas Limited ("Union") - Submissions Board File No. EB-2012-0392

This letter will update the Ontario Energy Board on Union Gas Limited ("Union") position on the above captioned project.

Representatives from Union's Underground Storage Group met with Den-Mar Brines Limited ("Den-Mar") on November 14, 2012, to discuss Den-Mar's injection well application. As you are aware the location of the proposed injection well is within 1.6 kilometres of Union's Bluewater Storage Pool, and Union has an interest in any drilling activities adjacent to its storage pools.

After reviewing Den-Mar's proposal, Union agrees with the Ministry of Natural Resources view that there will be no impacts on the Bluewater Storage Pool with the work that has been proposed by Den-Mar in its current application. If in the future, Den-Mar proposes additional work in the Sarnia 7-6-11 Pool, Union would like to be notified of these activities and be provided the opportunity to review and comment on the proposal.

Union will not be making any additional submissions on this file.
