NOTICE OF APPLICATION

ENBRIDGE GAS DISTRIBUTION INC. LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT NATURAL GAS PIPELINE DURHAM YORK ENERGY CENTRE

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board on November 12, 2012 under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B for an order granting leave to construct approximately 5.6 km of high pressure ("HP") steel pipeline consisting of two sections, one of Nominal Pipe Size ("NPS") 8 (8 inch diameter; 203 mm) in Bowmanville, Ontario and one section of NPS 6 (6 inch diameter; 152 mm) in Courtice, Ontario to provide distribution services to the Durham York Energy Centre ("DYEC") Facility in Courtice, Ontario (the "proposed pipeline"). The Board has assigned file number EB-2012-0382 to this application.

Section 1 of the proposed pipeline is approximately 2 km in length and begins at the intersection of Gaud Gate and Regional Road 57 in Bowmanville in the Municipality of Clarington. Section 1 travels north along Regional Road 57 and turns west to travel along Concession Road 4, where it ends at the intersection of Concession Road 4 and Old Scugog Road. Section 2 of the proposed pipeline is approximately 3.6 km in length and begins at the intersection of Bloor Street and Solina Road in Courtice in the Municipality of Clarington. Section 2 travels south on Solina Road, turns west along Baseline Road, turns south along McKnight, routes beneath Highway 401 to end at 72 Osbourne Road to service the DYEC Facility in Courtice.

A map showing the location of the proposed route is attached as Appendix "A" to this Notice.

The pipeline is to be located within existing road allowances. Construction of the pipeline is planned to start in late April or early May 2013. The proposed in-service timing for the pipeline is September 2013.

If you wish to give your opinion on the proceeding to the Board members hearing the application, you are invited to send a written letter of comment to the Board no later than **30 days** after the publication or service date of this notice. A complete copy of your letter of comment, including your name, contact information, and the content of the letter, will be provided to the applicant and the Hearing Panel. All letters of comment will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letter of comment on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the letter of comment (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter of comment will become part of the public record. Please address your letter of comment to the Board Secretary at the address below, and reference file number **EB-2012-0382** at the top of your letter.

Observe

If you do not wish to actively participate in the proceeding but you do wish to receive documents issued by the Board, you may request observer status. Your written request must be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. All letters requesting observer status will become part of the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be placed on the Board's website. Before placing the request for observer status on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the request (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail

address of an individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the request for observer status will become part of the public record.

If you wish to actively participate in the proceeding (e.g. submit questions, file argument), you may request intervenor status from the Board, no later than **10 days** after the publication or service date of this notice.
