Re: <u>EB-2012-0031 – HONI Transmission Rates (Interim ETS Rate)</u>

The Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO") is an intervenor in the above noted proceeding and wishes to make submissions in response to Procedural Order No. 9 with respect to the Export Transmission Service (ETS) rate.

As the independent market operator mandated to operate the IESO-administered market to promote the purposes of the *Electricity Act*, including promoting economic efficiency in the sale of electricity, it is the IESO's view that a retroactive application of the ETS rate would introduce an additional level of price uncertainty that could have a dampening effect on trading behaviour leading to less efficient market outcomes. For this reason, the IESO supports APPrO's position that the Board not order a retroactive adjustment of the ETS rate back to January 1, 2013, should the Board order a change in the rate.

The IESO also wishes to advise the Board of the IESO's settlement capabilities with respect to a new ETS rate. The IESO is able to implement a change in the ETS rate immediately and is also able to implement a retroactive application of the rate. However, should the Board order a rate with a different rate structure, i.e. a two tiered rate, the IESO would require a minimum of 4 months to make the required technical adjustments in its settlement systems to accommodate a change of that nature.
