NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING

UNION GAS LIMITED LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT NATURAL GAS PIPELINE OWEN SOUND REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Union Gas Limited ("Union") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on November 13, 2012 under sections 90 and 97 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B (the "Act"), for an order granting Union leave to construct approximately 25 kilometres ("km") of Nominal Pipe Size 12 ("NPS 12") hydrocarbon pipeline (the "Proposed Pipeline") to replace a portion of the existing Owen Sound Pipeline located in the Region of Waterloo. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2012-0430.

The Proposed Pipeline will begin at Union's Owen Sound valve site located on Northumberland Road just south of Highway 401 on Lot 34, Concession 9, in the Township of North Dumfries and end at the Waterloo Gate Station on Fischer-Hallman Road in the City of Waterloo, within the Region of Waterloo.

A map showing the location of the proposed pipeline route is attached as Appendix A to this Notice.

The Proposed Pipeline is to be located generally within road allowance. Construction of the Proposed Pipeline is planned to start in April 2013 and be completed by the end of November 2013.

Written Hearing

The Board intends to proceed with this matter by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant within **10 days** of the publication of this notice or the date it is served on you.

How to Participate

Comment

If you wish to give your opinion on the proceeding to the Board members hearing the application, you are invited to send a letter of comment to the Board no later than **30 days** after the publication of this notice or the date it is served on you. A complete copy of your letter of comment, including your name, contact information, and the content of the letter, will be provided to the applicant and the Board members hearing the application. All letters of comment will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letter of comment on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the letter of comment (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter of comment will become part of the public record. Please address your letter of comment to the Board Secretary at the address below, and reference file number **EB-2012-0430** at the top of your letter.

Observe

If you do not wish to actively participate in the proceeding but you do wish to receive documents issued by the Board, you may request observer status. Your written request must be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication of this notice

or the date it is served on you. All letters requesting observer status will become part of the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be placed on the Board's website. Before placing the request for observer status on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the request (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of an individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the request for observer status will become part of the public record.

Intervene

If you wish to actively participate in the proceeding (e.g. submit questions, file argument), you may request intervenor status from the Board, no later than **10 days** after the publication of this notice or the date it is served on you. Instructions for requesting intervenor status are available on the Board's website at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/participate. Everything an intervenor files with the Board, including the intervenor's name and contact information, will be placed on the public record, which can be seen at the Board's offices and on the Board's website.
