Jonathon,

Thank you for your response regarding my letter of comment, I am glad that the lot numbers have been cleared up and corrected.

I do disagree though that the error is not material to the application.

How can a document of such importance as an "Application for Leave to **Construct**" be accepted into files when it is incorrect. This, as I said, intimates that it has not been checked adequately and for a Professional Engineering company to release such an erroneous document is not proper.

I question the legality of such a document with wrong information, when it would be used to construct an important and controversial project.

Also there is no excuse by stating that my lot is possibly unique. It has been so, for a very long time, and it is well documented by maps and other county documents.

I also dispute the statement that the property in question does not form part of the proposed transmission route. Your department needs to visit the site of my property to see first hand that it will be impossible for DWP to place the pertinent poles for this transmission lines without placing them on my property. The environmental location is a "Ravine" and the embankment on the West side of the current rail corridor is almost vertical, which means the other side of that West ravine, over the top, is my property boundary.

I find it very strange that the whole application uses the premise that this power line will use the rail corridor, when in fact the existing Rail corridor, is, and has to be maintained open, in other words no poles can be placed on the actual rail corridor, "rail bed", they must be kept away from this passage. This is to accomodate not only ATV's and Snowmobiles, but also to allow for any future possibility of re-use as a railway.

Again I state that my house is only some sixty feet from the center of the old rail line.

So if DWP can place these eighteen meter poles without being on my property then you would be correct. However I challenge that position.
