AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Tillsonburg Hydro Inc. for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2013.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 December 10, 2012

Tillsonburg Hydro Inc. ("THI") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on November 8, 2012 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that THI charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2013. The Board has assigned the Application file number EB-2012-0168.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing dated November 16, 2012. Energy Probe and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility. No objection was received.

The Board has determined that Energy Probe and VECC are granted intervenor status and are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this Procedural Order.

The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories. The Board reminds parties that interrogatories must reference the pre-filed evidence and, in accordance with *Chapter 1 of the Filing Requirements for Transmission and Distribution Applications* ("Filling Requirements"), parties must sort their interrogatories and

responses by topics as outlined in the exhibits in the Filing Requirements. The Board encourages parties to use a continuous numbering system to facilitate subsequent referencing of the interrogatories. After its review of the responses, the Board will determine the next steps.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- Intervenors shall request any information and material from THI that is in addition to THI's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served to THI on or before January 4, 2013. Interrogatories from Board staff shall be submitted on or before January 4, 2013.
- 2. THI shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them to Intervenors on or before **January 22, 2013.**

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2012-0168, be made through the Board's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry</u>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
