Re: Integrated Grain Processors Co-operative Inc. Natural Resource Gas Limited Franchise Renewal Application EB-2012-0072

We are counsel to Integrated Grain Processors Co-operative Inc. ("IGPC") in this proceeding.

It is our understanding that there remains some uncertainty about the status and expiry date of certain Franchise Agreements between various municipalities and Natural Resource Gas Limited ("NRG"). It is noted that one of the options open to the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB"), as suggested by certain parties to this proceeding, is that the Franchise Agreement between the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer and NRG continue on an interim basis and that the Board deal with all of the NRG Franchise Agreements in one consolidated hearing in the future.

With some effort, IGPC has been able to determine the status of most of the Franchise Agreements with NRG. We have prepared the attached Table. In short, the status of the various Franchise Agreements can be summarized as follows:

- 1. There are four (4) Franchise Agreements that are the subject of an Interim Order extending the Franchise Agreements until the Board makes a final determination in respect of the respective franchise renewal applications. These are:
 - (a) The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre (EB-2012-0444);
 - (b) The City of London (i.e. the former Township of Westminster) (EB-2012-0445;
 - (c) The Corporation of the Municipality of Central Elgin (EB-2012-0446); and
 - (d) The Corporation of the Township of Bayham (EB-2012-0447).

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In addition, the Franchise Agreement with the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer, which is the subject of the within proceeding, is also the subject of a similar Interim Order.

This leaves the Corporation of the Township of Malahide, with a Franchise Agreement expiry of September 21, 2015 (assuming the latest expiry date applies), and the Franchise Agreement with the Corporation of the Township of South-west Oxford, the expiry date of which is unknown but assumed to be in the near future as the Franchise Agreement was to run for thirty years from the passing of the relevant By-law, which is believed to have occurred around 1982.

One area of question is the Franchise Agreement with the Corporation of Norfolk County, which includes the former Township of Norfolk. It is understood that NRG serves some of this County, but the expiry date of any Franchise Agreement is not readily apparent.

IGPC offers the above information in the hope that it is of assistance to the Board and Board Staff in their attempt to determine the status of relevant Franchise Agreements for the purposes of considering the proposal to consolidate all of the Franchise Agreement hearings into one hearing, contemporaneous with the date of the expiry of the latest agreement, likely the Corporation of the Township of Malahide.
