NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING

APPLICATION BY VARNA WIND INC. FOR LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT AN ELECTRICITY TRANSMISSION LINE AND RELATED FACILITIES IN HURON COUNTY

Varna Wind Inc. (the "Applicant") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board"), dated November 23, 2012, under sections 92 and 97 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B (the "Act"). The Applicant has applied for an order of the Board granting leave to construct an electricity transmission line and related facilities for the Bluewater Wind Energy Centre ("BWEC"), a wind farm generation facility and for Board approval of the form of agreements that have been or will be offered to landowners affected by the approved route. The Board has assigned file number EB-2012-0442 to this application.

The transmission line and related facilities (collectively, the "Transmission Facilities") include:

- (i) a 115 kV transmission line approximately 23 km in length;
- (ii) a newly constructed transforming substation that will step-up the voltage from 34.5 kV to 115 kV; and
- (iii) a newly constructed independent breaker to connect BWEC to Hydro One Networks Inc.'s Seaforth Transformer Station.

The BWEC will be located in Huron County in the municipalities of Bluewater and Huron East.

A map showing the location of the proposed Transmission Facilities is attached as Appendix A to this Notice.

The Applicant states that the proposed Transmission Facilities are needed to connect the BWEC to the Independent Electricity System Operator-controlled grid. The BWEC is a proposed 59.9 MW wind energy generation facility, which was awarded a 20 year power purchase agreement under the Ontario Power Authority's Feed-in-Tariff program in July 2011. The generation facility itself (i.e., the wind farm) is not part of the leave to construct application and does not fall within the scope of this proceeding.

Construction of the Transmission Facilities is planned to start in May 2013 and the proposed in-service date for the Transmission Facilities is between the last quarter of 2013 and the first quarter of 2014.

Board Jurisdiction

For a leave to construct application that is filed under section 92 of the Act, section 96 of the Act states that the Board shall consider the public interest and shall only consider the following two issues when deciding if the proposed project is in the public interest:

- the interests of consumers with respect to prices and the reliability and quality of electricity service; and
- (2) where applicable and in a manner consistent with the policies of the Government of Ontario, the promotion of the use of renewable energy sources.

The Board therefore has no power to review environmental issues. Environmental issues related to this project are to be considered through the Renewable Energy Approval process and parties should contact the Applicant directly for information on that process.

Written Hearing

The Board intends to proceed with this matter by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written

hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the Applicant within **10 days** of the publication or date of service on you of this notice.

How to Participate

Comment

If you wish to give your opinion on the proceeding to the Board Members hearing the application, you are invited to send a letter of comment to the Board no later than 30 days after the publication or date of service on you of this notice. A complete copy of your letter of comment, including your name, contact information, and the content of the letter, will be provided to the Applicant and the Board Members hearing the application.

Observe

If you do not wish to actively participate in the proceeding but you do wish to receive documents issued by the Board, you may request observer status. Your written request must be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or date of service on you of this notice.

Personal Information in Letters of Comment and Observer Requests

All letters of comment and letters requesting observer status will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letters on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e. not business) contact information from the letters (i.e. the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter will become part of the public record. Please address your letter to the Board Secretary at the address below, and reference file number EB-2012-0442 at the top of your letter.

Intervene

If you wish to actively participate in the proceeding (e.g., submit questions, file argument), you may request intervenor status from the Board no later than 10 days after the publication or service date of this notice.
