NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING

UNION GAS LIMITED LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT NATURAL GAS PIPELINE PANHANDLE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Union Gas Limited ("Union") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on November 29, 2012 under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B (the "Act"), for an order granting Union leave to construct approximately 500 metres of Nominal Pipe Size 16 ("NPS 16") hydrocarbon pipeline (the "Proposed Pipeline") in order to replace a portion of the existing Panhandle Line located in the City of Windsor. Union also requested, under section 95 of the Act, that the Board exempt Union from the requirements of section 90 of the Act. The Board does not believe that there are special circumstances in this case to warrant an exemption under section 95 of the Act; therefore, the Board is issuing this Notice of Application and Written Hearing. The Board also notes that Union will require Board approval of the form of easement agreements provided in the application (as required by section 97 of the Act). The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2012-0432.

A map showing the location of the Proposed Pipeline route is attached as Appendix A to this Notice.

Union will require a new easement from the City of Windsor to construct the Proposed Pipeline. The Proposed Pipeline will also be located within road allowances in the City of Windsor. Construction of the Proposed Pipeline is planned to start in March 2013 and be completed by the end of October 2013.

How to Participate in the Hearing

The Board intends to proceed with this matter by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant within **7 days** of the date this notice is served on you.

If you wish to participate in the written hearing, please file a written submission setting out your views on the application. You must forward three paper copies, and if possible, an electronic copy in Word format and in searchable PDF format, of your submission to the Board and one copy to the applicant at the addresses below. All submissions must be received no later than **10 days** after the date this notice is served on you. If the applicant wishes to respond to the submissions, such response must be filed with the Board and copied to any party that made submissions no later than **17 days** after the service date of this notice.

All submissions must quote the relevant file number, and clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.

All written submissions sent to the Board will be placed on the public record, which means that the written submissions will be available for viewing at the Board's offices and will be placed on the Board's website.

If the written submission is from a private citizen (i.e., not a lawyer representing a client, not a consultant representing a client or organization, not an individual in an organization that represents the interests of consumers or other groups, and not an individual from a regulated entity), before placing the written submission on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the written submission (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the written submission will become part of the public record.

As stated elsewhere in this notice, you must provide a complete copy of your written submission (including your name, contact information, and everything written in the submission) to the applicant.
