NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING

ENBRIDGE GAS DISTRIBUTION INC. LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT NATURAL GAS PIPELINE INNES ROAD PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board on December 11, 2012 under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B for an order granting it leave to construct approximately 2.8 km of extra high pressure ("XHP") steel pipeline and ancillary facilities along Innes Road in the City of Ottawa, Ontario. The Board has assigned file number EB-2012-0438 to this application.

The proposed route begins at the intersection of Blair Road and Innes Road and proceeds west along Innes Road for approximately 2.8 km to the end point in the vicinity of St. Laurent Boulevard in the City of Ottawa.

A map showing the location of the proposed route is attached as Appendix "A" to this Notice.

The pipeline will mostly follow the existing road allowances. Construction of the pipeline is planned to start in May 2013. The proposed in-service timing for the pipeline is October 2013.

A complete copy of your letter of comment, including your name, contact information, and the content of the letter, will be provided to the applicant and the Board members hearing the application. All letters of comment will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letter of comment on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the letter of comment (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter of comment will become part of the public record. Please address your letter of comment to the Board Secretary at the address below, and reference file number **EB-2012-0438** at the top of your letter.

<u>Observe</u>
