Re: The Matter of the Ontario Energy Act 1998

And in the Matter of an application by Varna Wind Incorporation(the applicant) for an Order granting leave to construct an electricity transmission line and related facilities in the County of Huron and for approval of the form of easement agreement which has been offered to landowners(the transmission easement)

I request Intervener Status

1. I am presently the owner of North Part Lot 25 Concession 4 L.R.S. 41755 Centennial Road. The transmission line is proposed to travel along the entire length of my property, if approved. To date, I have not received a legal notice from Nextera Energy Canada. I was made aware by our neighbours and an ad that appeared in the local paper on Jan 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2013. I received no personal notice as is required by the board.
2. The timing of the application was in December during a busy holiday time.
3. The depth of the application is 420 plus pages.
4. Re: Information requested. In the past I have requested information as to the exact location of the proposed line and type of construction. To date this information has not been received.
5. Re: Public Meeting. At the last public meeting I requested that the applicant conduct a stray voltage test of my residence. If after construction there are ill effects then I will conduct a study and the applicant will correct the problem. To date, no reply.
6. Re; Lack of Information. I requested information as to the setback from residence, livestock operation and public facilities. To date, no information has been provided.
7. Re: Guarantees. In the application, no mention is made as to the guarantees that will be provided to the municipality or the adjacent owners.
8. Re: Road Allowance Usage Agreement. The affected property owners are not aware of a usage agreement with the local municipality. I feel the application is premature.
9. Re: Hearing. I object to a written hearing in this matter. I prefer an oral hearing where all the affected parties can be part of the approval process
