**Re: Owen Sound Pipeline Project - Union Gas Limited  
Information Session: August 27, 2012**

Dear Landowner:

To help meet the growing demand for natural gas, Union Gas is proposing to construct approximately 24 km of NPS 12-inch diameter natural gas pipeline in the Kitchener/Waterloo area.

Azimuth Environmental Consulting has been retained by Union Gas to prepare an Environmental Report for the proposed Owen Sound Pipeline Project.

The pipeline will begin at the Union Gas Owen Sound Valve Site (OSV) located on Northumberland Road just south of Highway 401 on Lot 34, Concession 9 in the Township of North Dumfries and end at the Waterloo Gate Station on Fischer-Hallman Rd. in the City of Waterloo, within the Region of Waterloo. (See attached Figure 1).

The pipeline will be constructed in two parts:

1. A 12 km section of existing pipeline between OSV and Bleams Road will be removed and replaced with a new pipeline in the same trench, within the existing easement.
2. A second 12 km section of existing pipeline between Bleams Road and Waterloo Gate Station is located in a residential area. To reduce property disturbance this section will be decommissioned and left in place with a new section of pipeline constructed within the road allowance. The preliminary preferred route for this section of pipeline travels along Bleams Rd. and then proceeds west to Trussler Rd./Ira Needles Blvd., where it will then proceed north to Erb St. W., turn east to Fischer – Hallman Rd., and north to the Waterloo Gate Station. In addition to provide security to the existing system, two 2km sections of pipeline will run from Bleams Rd. north along Fischer – Hallman Rd., to the Kitchener Gate Station.



**An Information Session will be held on August 27, 2012 at the Country Hills Community Centre located at 100 Rittenhouse Road in Kitchener 5:00 – 8:00 p.m.**

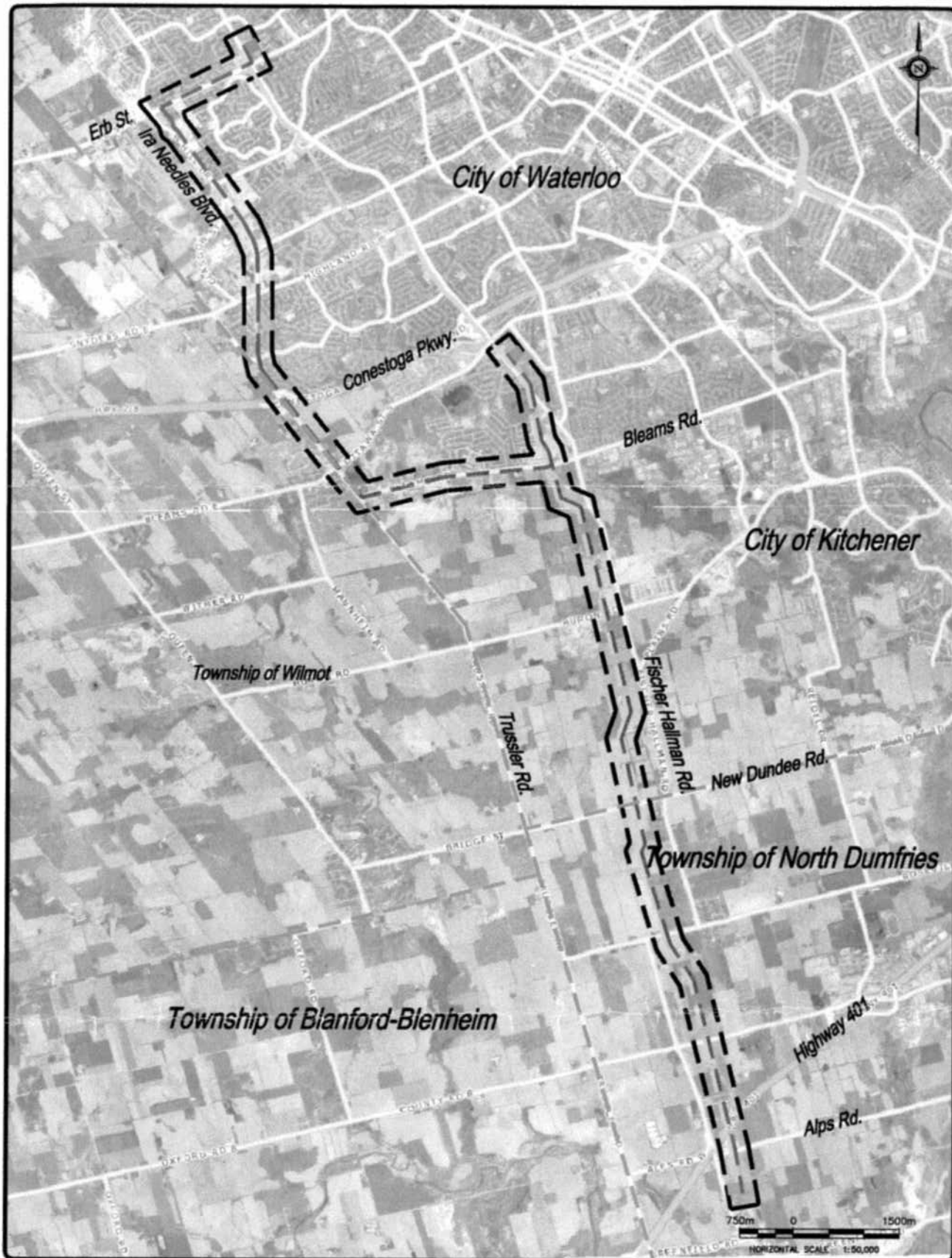
