Re: **Board File No. EB-2012-0460 - Application for an Electricity Generation Licence**

On December 5, 2012, 2252112 Ontario Inc. ("2252112") filed an *Application for an Electricity Generation Licence* ("Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board"). The Board assigned file number EB-2012-0373 to this matter. Pursuant to filing the Application, 2252112 was made aware that the *Generation Licence* may not be granted due to the total name plate capacity of the generation facilities is less than 500 kilowatts.

Section 57(c) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 provides that no person is permitted to generate electricity or provide ancillary services for sale through the IESO-administered markets or directly to another person without a licence. One exemption to this regulation is that very small generators that own or operate one or more generation facilities with a total name plate capacity of 500 kilowatts or less are exempt from the need to obtain a generation licence. The Application filed by 2252112 included three completed generation facilities with a total name plate capacity of 290 kilowatts.

Although the exemption for generation facilities with a total name plate capacity of 500 kilowatts or less is in effect, 2252112 is respectively seeking approval from the Board for a Generation License. 2252112 are in the process of constructing additional generation facilities which upon completion will provide it with total name plate capacity in excess of 500 kilowatts. The expected time for completion of these facilities is July 2013. Additionally, 2252112 are applying for financing to assist with its capital requirements and one condition of the finance company is that 2252112 obtain a *Generation Licence*.

2252112 does not consider this request to have a material impact on any other party, and asks that the Board deliberate on the proceeding without a hearing under section 21(4)(b) of the *Act*.






