IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Union Gas Limited for an order pursuant to sections 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, granting leave to construct a natural gas pipeline and facilities in the Municipality of Leamington and the Town of Lakeshore, in the County of Essex.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 February 4, 2013

Union Gas Limited ("Union") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on November 23, 2012 under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act,* 1998 (the "Act"), for an order granting Union leave to construct approximately 8.5 kilometres of Nominal Pipe Size 12 natural gas pipeline (the "Proposed Pipeline") in the Municipality of Leamington and the Town of Lakeshore, in the County of Essex. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2012-0431.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Written Hearing (the "Notice") dated January 10, 2013.

No person has requested intervenor status in this proceeding.

The Board notes that Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. requested observer status.

The Board considers it necessary to make provisions for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff may file written interrogatories with the Board and serve them on Union on or before **February 8**, **2013**.
- 2. Union shall file complete interrogatory responses with the Board on or before **February 15, 2013**.
- 3. Board staff may file a written submission with the Board and serve it on Union on or before **February 27, 2013**.
- 4. Union may file a reply submission with the Board on or before **March 8, 2013**.

All filings to the Board must quote file numbers **EB-2012-0431** be made through the Board's web portal at www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/ and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.

If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the BoardSec@ontarioenergyboard.ca.
