PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 February 5, 2013

SunE Norfolk Bloomsburg LP ("SunE") filed an application on December 19, 2012 with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for an electricity generation licence as a Feed-in Tariff Program participant.

The Board's Notice of Application and Written Hearing (the "Notice") for this proceeding was published on January 8, 2013. The Notice stated that the application will be decided by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for holding an oral hearing. The Notice included timelines for interested parties to file written objections to proceeding by way of a written hearing, for interested parties to file written submissions on the merits of the application, and for the applicant to respond to any written submissions.

The Board received one submission on January 29, 2013 from the Six Nations Council ("Six Nations"). On February 5, 2013, the Board received a request for an extension from SunE for filing its reply submission from February 5, 2013 to February 12, 2013. SunE stated that the reason for the extension request is because it received the submission from Six Nations on February 1, 2013.

I will grant the extension and find it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The applicant's response to the submission filed must be filed with the Board and copied to the party having filed the submission by **February 12, 2013**.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2012-0467, be made through the Board's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
