SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION ON COST ELIGIBILITY #2
March 5, 2013

On October 18, 2012, the Board released its “Report of the Board: A Renewed Regulatory Framework for Electricity Distributors: A Performance Based Approach” (the “RRFE Report”). In the letter accompanying the release of the RRFE Report (the “October 18 Letter”) the Board: (i) announced the consultation activities that would be undertaken for the purposes of implementing the policies set out in the RRFE Report (the “Consultation Activities”); (ii) indicated that cost awards would be available to eligible persons under section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* in relation to their participation in one or more of the Consultation Activities; (iii) further indicated that it would not grandfather cost award eligibility awarded prior to the issuance of the October 18 Letter, and that stakeholders wishing to be eligible for cost awards would

therefore have to apply for cost eligibility status; and (iv) established October 29, 2012 as the deadline for the filing of requests for cost eligibility.

On February 14, 2013, the Board received a request for cost eligibility from the Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario ("FRPO"). In its request, FRPO apologized for the late filing, and stated that it had failed to note the requirement to request cost award eligibility in respect of the Consultation Activities as set out in the October 18 Letter.

Rate-regulated licensed electricity transmitters and distributors were given an opportunity to file any objections that they might have in relation to FRPO's cost eligibility request. No objections were filed.

Based on the criteria set out in section 3 of the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, the Board has determined that FRPO is eligible for an award of costs in respect of its participation in all of the Consultation Activities for which it has requested eligibility.

The Board takes this opportunity to draw FRPO's attention to the Board's January 8, 2013 Decision on Cost Eligibility, and in particular to the statements regarding cost awards generally that appear at the end of that Decision and that apply to all eligible participants.
