- d. All generators connected directly to the Hydro One Networks Inc. transmission lines to which the proposed line will connect;
- e. All transmission customers of Hydro One Networks Inc. connected directly to the transmission lines to which the proposed line will connect;
- f. All owners and operators of rail lines, telecommunications (e.g., telephone) or other utilities along or crossing the routes proposed for the project;
- g. The Clerks of all Municipalities that would be affected by the project;
- All Aboriginal communities with any interest in the lands affected by the subject project, including Aboriginal communities identified by the Director of the Ministry of the Environment as stated in Appendix I (letter dated March 10, 2011) of the "Consultation Report (Abitibi Solar Project)", Oct 18, 2012 [see Application, Exhibit .G, Tab 1, Schedule 2].

  - **NOTE**: Please make it clear to each newspaper that invoices regarding publication are to be sent to the Applicant and not to the Board.
- 5. To file with the Board affidavit evidence proving the above service and publication immediately upon completion, with the relevant Notices and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices. It is not necessary for the affidavits of publication to have newspaper tear sheets attached.
- 6.
