AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. for an order or orders related to deferral and variance accounts and the adoption of USGAAP for regulatory accounting purposes.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 6 March 11, 2013

Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG") filed an application, dated September 24, 2012 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B) seeking approval for an order or orders related to deferral and variance accounts, including disposition of balances as at December 31, 2012, and the adoption of the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles of the United States ("USGAAP") for regulatory accounting purposes.

In Procedural Order No. 5, issued on February 25, 2013, the Board set out the dates for the filing of the settlement proposal arising from the settlement conference, and a settlement hearing to review the settlement proposal. On March 8, 2013, OPG filed correspondence requesting an extension from March 8, 2013 to March 15, 2013 to file the settlement proposal. The Board grants the extension and has re-scheduled the settlement hearing for the presentation of the settlement proposal to the Board accordingly.

The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Settlement Proposal arising from the Settlement Conference shall be filed with the Board no later than **March 15, 2013**.
- 2. The Board will sit on **March 25, 2013** at 1:00 p.m. in the Board's hearing room on the 25th Floor at 2300 Yonge Street, Toronto, to review the Settlement Proposal.

All filings to the Board must quote file number **EB-2012-0002**, be made through the Board's web portal at <u>www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry</u>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
