IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Bluewater Power Distribution Corporation for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2013.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 4 March 28, 2013

Bluewater Power Distribution Corporation ("Bluewater Power") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 22, 2012 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Bluewater Power charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2013.

In Procedural Order No. 3, issued on February 12, 2013, the Board made provision for written supplemental interrogatories followed by a settlement conference. In the event that a complete settlement was not achieved, the Board made provision for an oral hearing to examine the outstanding issues.

In correspondence filed on March 27, 2013, Bluewater Power reported that the parties had reached a complete settlement, but stated that it would not be able to file the settlement proposal by March 28, 2013 as set out in Procedural Order No. 3. Bluewater Power requested an extension to April 5, 2013.

The Board grants the extension requested by Bluewater Power and hereby cancels the March 28, 2013 settlement proposal filing date and the April 4 and 5, 2013 oral hearing dates established in Procedural Order No. 3.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The procedural dates set out in Procedural Order No. 3 are cancelled.
- 2. The Settlement Proposal arising from the Settlement Conference shall be filed with the Board no later than **April 5**, **2013**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, **EB-2012-0107**, be made through the Board's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
