Re: Applications for 2014 Electricity Rates

By letter dated December 11, 2012, the Board identified Hearst Power Distribution Company Limited ("Hearst") as one of the distributors expected to file its 2014 rate application on a cost of service basis assuming it opts for the new Fourth Generation Incentive Rate-setting method ("4th generation IR)" established in the *Report of the Board: A Renewed Regulatory Framework for Electricity.* The Board is in receipt of your letter requesting that Hearst be permitted to defer the rebasing of its rates beyond the 2014 rate year.

The Board has considered the rationale for deferral set out in your letter, as well as the following:

- Hearst's financial position, as shown in its audited financial statements and financial reporting to the Board; and
- Hearst's 3-year performance with respect to system reliability indicators and electricity service quality requirements/indicators, as reported to the Board.

Based on these considerations, the Board has concluded that it will not require Heart's 2014 rates to be set on a cost of service basis. The Board will place Hearst on the list of distributors whose rates will be scheduled for rebasing for the 2015 rate year.

If Hearst intends to seek a rate adjustment for 2014 rates, the Board expects Hearst to adhere to the process for 4th generation IR distribution rate applications for the 2014 rate year as may be determined by the Board.
