Application for Leave to Construct (the “Application”)

Board Order #1 of Procedural Order No. 4 (April 5, 2013) states that, “K2 Wind and the Residents Group shall file with the Board and deliver to all parties any submissions they wish to make in support of their respective Motions on or before April 8, 2013.” It is our understanding that K2 Wind will be filing additional written submissions in support of the Notice of Motion it filed on April 1, 2013. We would like to make the following additional written submission:

In its application to the Board, K2 Wind has, in part, supported the approval of the K2 Wind Project on the following basis:

(iii) the SIA (and the Addendum) and CIA Reports filed as part of this application support the conclusion that the interconnection of the Proposed Facilities with the IESO-controlled grid will not adversely affect the reliability and quality of electricity service in Ontario.

Would K2 Wind please clarify this statement. Does this mean that the IESO supports the conclusion that the interconnection point of the K2 Wind Project will not affect the reliability and stability of the transmission grid or does it mean that the IESO supports the conclusion that there will be no grid instability or reliability issues caused by adding more large scale intermittent wind power projects to the transmission grid.

Also, would the Board please clarify whether or not the dates for Orders #4 and #5 from Procedural Order No. 2 will change due to the timelines set out for the Orders in Procedural Order No. 4.
