Re: EB-2013-0081: Natural Resource Gas Limited ("NRG") - Application by Integrated Grain Processors Co-operative Inc. ("IGCP") under ss. 42(3) of the Ontario Energy Board Act (the "*Act*")

We are legal counsel to the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer. We write on its behalf to confirm that it is requesting intervener status in the above-noted matter.

The Town has received a copy of the Notice of Application issued by the Board dated April 2, 2013 in this matter, as one of the parties to EB-2010-0018. NRG supplies natural gas customers within the municipal boundaries of the Town pursuant to an Order of the Ontario Energy Board. The Applicant, IGPC, is one of those customers, as the plant served pipeline that is the subject of IGPC's s. 42(3) application is within the municipal boundaries of the Town. The Town has been closely involved in the development and financial support of the IGPC plant since its conception. That project has been a vital economic development initiative for the Town and surrounding communities, and the proposed expansion that is the subject of the s. 42(3) application also has that character. The Town has taken part, including being granted intervenor status, in proceedings before this Board relating to that project since 2006, including EB-2006-0243, EB-2008-0273, EB-2010-0018. As such, the Town has a direct interest in the issues raised regarding the obligation to supply natural gas to the IGPC plant and the proposed expansion project.
