**Re: EB-2012-0433 and EB-2013-0074 Union Facilities Applications - GEC Intervention**

1. The Green Energy Coalition (GEC) hereby seeks intervenor status in these matters and requests that it be found eligible for costs. GEC's intervention will focus on the need for the project and the relative costs and impacts of the competing alternatives. GEC seeks late intervenor status in the EB-2012-0433 case.
