NOTICE OF APPLICATION GAS FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF MADOC

UNION GAS LIMITED

On April 15, 2013, Union Gas Limited ("Union") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board under the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M55, for an order approving the terms and conditions upon which, and the period for which, the Corporation of the Township of Madoc is, by by-law, to grant to Union the right to operate works and add to works for the distribution of gas in the Township of Madoc for a period of 20 years, and for an order declaring and directing that the assent of the municipal electors is not necessary.

Union also applied for an order granting it a new Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Township of Madoc to supersede its existing certificate (F.B.C.269) for the township.

The application has been assigned Board file numbers EB-2013-0103 (regarding the request for a franchise agreement) and EB-2013-0104 (regarding the request for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity).

The application will be decided by the Manager, Natural Gas Applications, who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). The Manager, Natural Gas Applications does not intend to provide for an award of costs when deciding the application.

How to Participate

<u>Comment</u>

If you wish to give your opinion on the proceeding you are invited to send a written letter of comment to the Board no later than **30 days** after the publication or service date of this notice. A complete copy of your letter of comment, including your name, contact information, and the content of the letter, will be provided to the applicant and the Board. All letters of comment will be placed on the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be available on the Board's website. Before placing the letter of comment on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the letter of comment (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the letter of comment to the Board Secretary at the address below, and reference file number **EB-2013-0103 and EB-2013-0104** at the top of your letter.

<u>Observe</u>

If you do not wish to actively participate in the proceeding but you do wish to receive documents issued by the Board, you may request observer status. Your written request must be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. All letters requesting observer status will become part of the public record, which means that the letters can be seen at the Board's offices and will be placed on the Board's website.
