Costs Eligibility

The School Energy Coalition ("Schools") is eligible for a cost award because it "primarily represents the interests of consumers (e.g. ratepayers) in relation to regulated services". School boards are one of the largest groups of non-industrial energy consumers in the province, and their energy costs have a direct impact on the education of millions of Ontario children. The formation of the School Energy Coalition ensured that all representatives of the interests of schools participated jointly in OEB proceedings. Schools has been awarded costs in many cases at the OEB in the past. Schools is not ineligible by reason of any of the criteria contained in section 3.05 of the Practice Direction on Cost Awards.
