reasonable rates and other service charges for the distribution of  
electricity, effective May 1, 2013.

**BOMA Submission**

Enersource Hydro Mississauga Inc. ("Enersource") filed an application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on February 15, 2013, under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, seeking approval for changes to the distribution rates that Enersource charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2013.

The application is based on the recovery of costs associated with lost revenues in 2011 and 2012 from the persistence of conservation and demand management ("CDM") programs implemented prior to 2011.

Enersource has requested a total LRAM recovery of \$1,753,174, including carrying charges. Enersource's LRAM claim consists of two parts:

1. An LRAM claim of \$867,440 associated with the persisting effects of 2005 to 2010 CDM programs in 2011
2. An LRAM claim of \$850,881 associated with the persisting effects of 2005 to 2010 CDM programs in 2012. Enersource has also requested approval of \$34,853 which represents the applicable carrying charges on the entire LRAM amount.

Enersource has requested recovery over a period of twenty months beginning on May 1, 2013 and ending on December 31, 2014.

BOMA supports Enersource's LRAM claim of \$1,753,174, and the proposed recovery period.
