BOMA Final Submissions

1. BOMA has carefully reviewed Powerstream's prefiled evidence and its interrogatory responses to BOMA and to other intervenors;
2. Powerstream's original submission demonstrated creativity, a keen understanding of CDM and conformance with the CDM Code and Guidelines. In its responses to BOMA Toronto's Interrogatories as well as those of the other intervenors, PowerStream has further demonstrated a thorough analysis of the shortfalls that would result if it was restricted to the Province Wide Programs. Clearly PowerStream has strongly contributed to efforts to improve both the OPA's province wide programs and the OPA's change management process. PowerStream has carefully reviewed the gaps in the province wide programs and assessed a broad array of options. Some of these options could readily be developed into programs as well; and
3. Accordingly BOMA recommends that PowerStream's proposed program be approved.
